"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

In following diocesan suggestions for the 2024-2025 school year, we are happy to announce that, with the input and recommendation of our Finance Council, we have approved a 3% salary increase for school faculty for the 2024-2025 school year. Faculty will receive a 1.9% step in addition to the 3.0% as in years past. We are aware that the reality of inflation has caused the cost of living to increase for all of us. We believe it is necessary to support our high-quality teachers and staff in a time when we are experiencing a teacher shortage in the state of Illinois, and reliable, hard-working support staff are in great demand. To be able to accomplish this, tuition rates will increase 4.2% for the 2024-2025 school year. We take very carefully the calculation to balance the needed salary increase with its effect on tuition. Our other means of support for our schools, including our Annual Fund and your regular contributions to the parish, make it possible to offer a larger increase to salary than increase to tuition. We are blessed to be in such a position that we can make these changes in this manner.

We begin the availability of your Lenten take home kit which highlights our Wednesday Lenten days of devotion and includes the Black Book and examinations of conscience for use in preparing for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. They will be available next weekend and through Ash Wednesday.

I pray you have a blessed week, I will be enjoying the warmth and quiet of St. Kitts this week with some classmates from the seminary.
