We moved this to 5:30 p.m. this year to be consistent with our Holy Day Masses, and is hopefully more convenient if you choose to go to Mass after work.

Ash Wednesday February 14th, 2024

Mass Times at St. Anthony 6:30am, 8:30am, 12:10pm & 5:30pm

The season of Lent begins this year on Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024, and ends just prior to the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, when the Paschal Triduum begins. Lent is the principal penitential season in the Church year. All the Christian faithful are urged to develop and maintain a voluntary program of self denial (in addition to the Lenten regulations), serious prayer and the performing of deeds of charity and mercy, including the giving of alms.

Lenten Regulations

1. ABSTINENCE – Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

2. FAST – Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.

3. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.
