“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

We rejoice in the gift of the Eucharist and Confirmation which thirty-seven of our third graders received this past Saturday, May 4th, at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Springfield. I want to thank their parents, sponsors, teachers and catechists from our St. Anthony School and Parish School of Religion, for making this preparation a priority for them in their lives of faith. You will notice that each family has a banner on the ends of the pews in Church to commemorate this joyful event. May they always be drawn to the Eucharist as their strength and may the Holy Spirit strengthen, inspire and lead them always! Congratulations!

Last week we shared the news that Fr. Michael Berndt has received a new assignment to become the Pastor of St. Charles Borromeo Parish in Charleston and Chaplain of the Newman Center at Eastern Illinois University. We certainly wish him well in this new assignment and thank him for his joyful service at St. Anthony these last three years. Securing Our Future Campaign Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q: What is the goal of the Educational Trust Campaign?

A: We are asking our parish families, school families, alumni, and even our local businesses to help "Secure Our Future" and surpass our goal of \$5.5 million. Equal sacrifice will help us increase the assets of the Educational Trust, in turn providing more support to St. Anthony School families for years to come.

Q: Why is a campaign necessary? Why now?

A: With the Invest in Kids Act ending on December 31, 2023, school families are losing over \$430,000 in scholarships annually. That's over \$2,000,000 in the next 5 years.

The Diocese of Springfield has also started a Centennial Campaign to support diocesan needs as well as the needs of individual parishes. Our parish goal for the Centennial Campaign would be around \$2,500,000.

Since the parish and schools do not have deferred maintenance, outstanding debt, or gaps in ministry, the parish is able to channel campaign efforts towards the Educational Trust, creating a unified mission to support our schools and school families.

Q: Will giving to the Educational Trust campaign have a negative effect on Sunday giving, the Annual Fund, and other efforts?

A: No! We are asking that your five-year gift be over and above your regular giving. We do not want to undermine the parish and schools' present ministries with reduced giving.

How to PRAY for abused children:

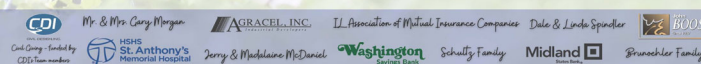
1. Pray they will be rescued

10. **You can make a difference -- Take action right away** if a child has been abused.

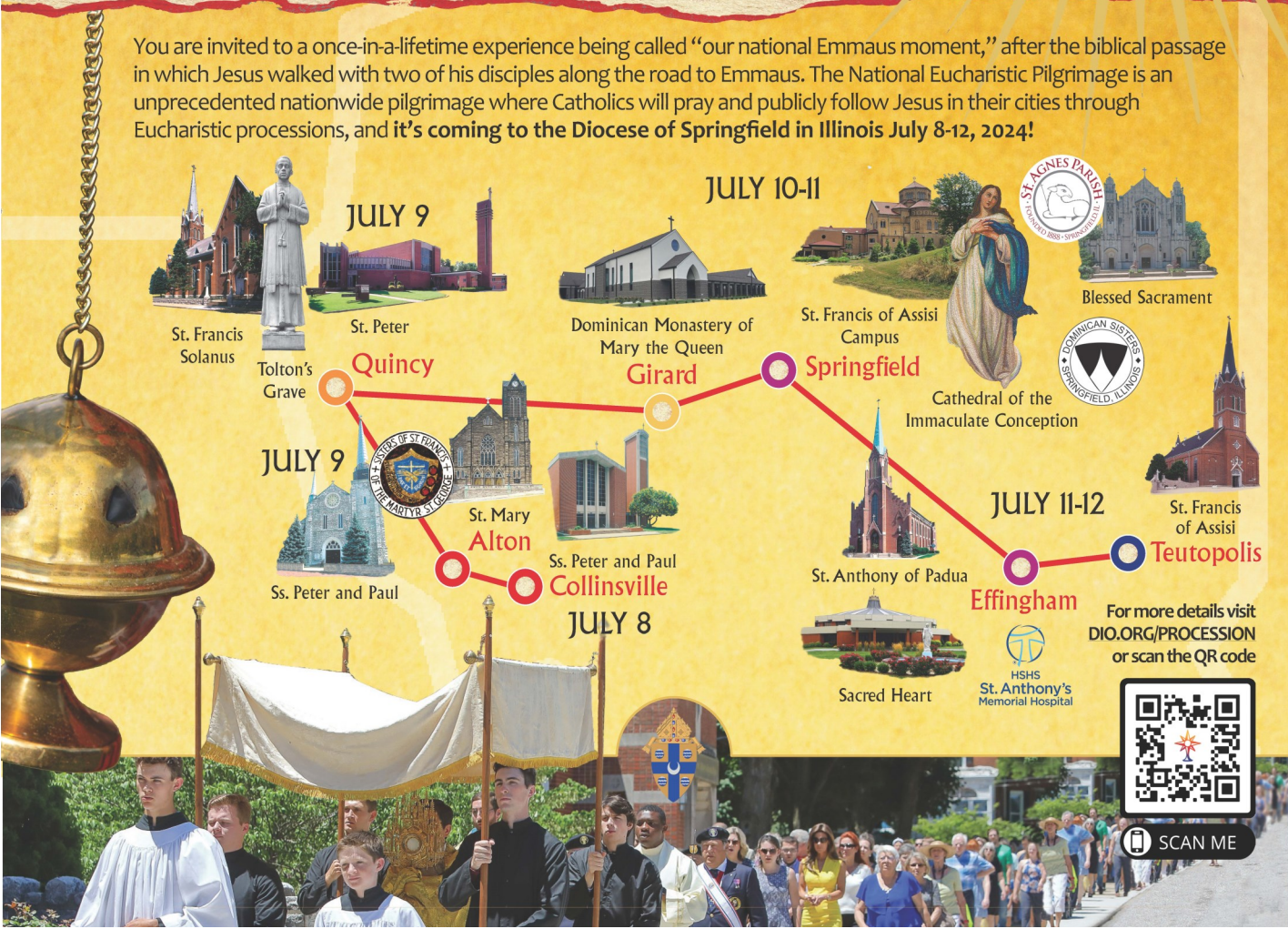
