Securing Our Future Campaign Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q: What is the goal of the Educational Trust Campaign?

A: We are asking our parish families, school families, alumni, and even our local businesses to help "Secure Our Future" and surpass our goal of \$5.5 million. Equal sacrifice will help us increase the assets of the Educational Trust, in turn providing more support to St. Anthony School families for years to come.

Q: Why is a campaign necessary? Why now?

A: With the Invest in Kids Act ending on December 31, 2023, school families are losing over \$430,000 in scholarships annually. That's over \$2,000,000 in the next 5 years.




