# "From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

A reminder to plan on joining our celebration of the Feast of St. Anthony, Thursday June 13. We will commemorate the day with a Mass in the evening, at 6:30 p.m. (there will be no 8:30 a.m. that day) and offer a cookout and dessert afterwards. We will use this as the time for the parish to say goodbye to Fr. Michael Berndt and thank him for his service among us these last three years, as his last weekend with us will be June 22 and 23.

Last weekend we addressed the question of how much one should consider in pledging to the Educational Trust Campaign. Obviously, no one else can tell you what a meaningful and sacrificial gift would be for you. Perhaps a five-year pledge would allow you to symbolically cover the cost of one year's St. Anthony High School tuition. A little over \$1000 per year would allow you to do that. If that is a sacrifice, I ask you to consider it. If that is not really that much of a sacrifice, then perhaps your pledge would be the number that it actually costs to educate each child, that's a total of \$8800.00 or \$1760.00 per year for five years. If you think, I can't really make up the difference between those two numbers...well then you understand the whole point of the campaign. We don't ask you to do even over 5 years what we don't ask each family to do each year. Shared sacrifice is what this is all about! Thank you for helping us secure the future. We are at 60% of our \$5.5 Million goal. Help us finish off strong.

As spring is turning into summer, I want to thank all those who help make our property and grounds look so good. Planting flowers and placing mulch at the right time, but cutting grass and edging the walkways is constant. It looks so wonderful, thank you for your dedication and pride in St. Anthony.

Please join us Monday for Mass at St. Anthony Cemetery at 9:30 a.m. That will be the only Mass of the day. Enjoy your Memorial Day weekend!

**Q:** Is the distribution from the Educational Trust replacing the parish's subsidy to St. Anthony Schools?


A: The Educational Trust distribution will not replace the parish's subsidy to the school. The Trust's distribution compliments the parish subsidy. Both are integral in keeping tuition affordable for school families.

The increased distribution from the Educational Trust is intended to replace scholarship monies that are lost with the sunset of the Invest in Kids Act.

Q: Since this is a 5-year pledge, what timeframe each year are you expecting our donation to be received?

**A:** We are asking donors to make their first gift between April 2024 and September 2024. Gifts for years two through five can be made in the same timeframe each year.


