Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

This is usually a note from me in this section, but in anticipation of his arrival on Monday, I asked Fr. Jayke White, our new Parochial Vicar, to introduce himself to us:



Howdy! I’m recently-ordained Father Jayke White, and I’m really looking forward to coming to St. Anthony! Here’s a little bit about me.

I’m the oldest of three children, I have a sister just a year younger than me and a brother who recently finished his second year of college. I grew up in Glen Carbon, Illinois and graduated from Edwardsville High School. My home parish is St. Mary’s in Edwardsville and, growing up, I enjoyed serving as a lector, PSR teacher, and Eucharist Minister.

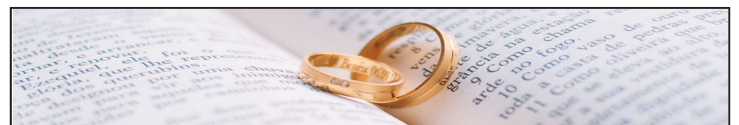

34th Annual Family Camp September 28 - 29, 2024

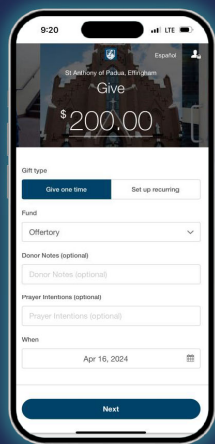

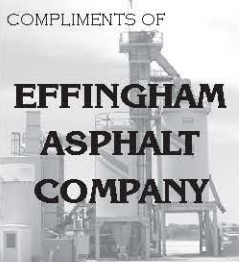

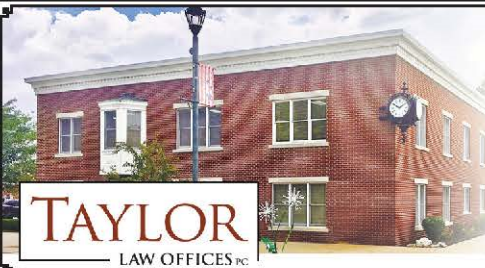
