"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

Over the summer we have received various inquiries from our outreach to those who have expressed an interest in joining the Catholic Church. You will see the information in the bulletin in the weeks to come. We are now in the process of contacting those who have asked about this process. Called the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, OCIA was previously known as the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). This new name better describes the whole process of joining the Catholic Church, not just the actual entrance rites. As you can imagine, people come into this process from wide and various backgrounds. Some have no familiarity with the Church, and some may be baptized Christians who are married to a Catholic and have come to Mass for years. Therefore, a "one-size fits all" approach is not always the most appropriate. This past year, in addition to the Baptism and Reception into the Church at the Easter Vigil, we brought three Christians into the faith through Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Communion individually as we met with them for catechesis and received them when they were ready.

I have found that the first step in making this conversion fruitful and lasting is to clarify the commitment taken by Catholics and help those inquiring about the faith to form the habit of Sunday Mass attendance. Our communication with them when they contact us begins with this: "The first and greatest component in this faith journey is your own time commitment to prayer and formation. The foundation of the Catholic faith is the reception of the Sacrament of the Eucharist at the celebration of Mass each Sunday (or vigil Mass Saturday evening). Our personal prayer and learning of the faith are built upon and depend upon this first commitment. This is an obligation of every Catholic, so we want you to be comfortable and in the practice of attending weekly Mass before we begin your formation and catechesis. We realize that not everyone has the ability or desire to committ to this expectation immediately. Therefore, we want you to proceed with this initiation when you feel comfortable making the commitment. That may be right now, or that may take some reflection. We do not want to rush you in this initial discernment. With this in mind, we ask that you connect with one of our parish priests to set up an initial appointment. There is no commitment when making this first inquiry, and we will be honest about the expectations and answer many of the questions you may have."

So, our plan is to contact those who express interest with this information and assess the numbers and situations of those who respond. We will organize a group for OCIA or work with individuals, depending on the response. If you know of someone, please pray and invite them!

We look forward to the picnic next weekend. Let's pray for good weather, a successful turnout, and a time of joy and fraternity!


SDCCW Convention August 28, 2024






