“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

This week the priests of the diocese gather together for our annual clergy convocation. It will be held in Collinsville, Illinois from Monday afternoon through Thursday afternoon, September 16-19. It is one of the few times that all of the priests are able to gather together, and in fact we are expected to do so. It is the only time of the year where we are all gathered together for any significant time. In addition to the topics which are presented for our continued theological education, the time to share in fraternity with the other priests of the diocese is a real blessing. For this reason, there will not be daily Mass Tuesday through Thursday, but will begin again on Friday September 20.

This weekend I was able to share with you by mail and with a few words at the Masses the annual report of our stewardship. I was able to summarize my great gratitude and optimism by pointing out the following:

- For our current year, 2024-2025, we are providing \$189,544 in parish scholarships to 70 families (124 students). For 2023-2024, we had provided \$428,475 in Invest in Kids scholarships to 78 families (140 students). While the dollars don't match, our scholarship program evaluates families differently than Invest in Kids. We've provided a good amount of scholarship dollars to these families, and the families have been willing to step up and meet us in the middle.
- Since we ended the fiscal year strong, we were able to complete extra work around campus without having to ask for financial support. Those projects included: In Repairs & Maintenance, we included the parking lots (across from church and the grade school partial lot) for \$57,595.00. We also included 1/2 of the cost of the HS roof replacement, which was \$75,450.00. You will see that amount in the accounts payable on the balance sheet as well. In Technology, we upgraded the HS teacher MacBooks for \$21,580.00, and purchased iPads for the new iPad cart at \$8,678.00. In Furniture & Equipment, we included 30 new desks for the HS at \$6,419.40, and window shades for the parish center for \$12,990.00.
- Our regular church support increased \$75,000 over the prior year!
- Our St. Anthony Schools Annual Fund had a record-breaking year. We far surpassed our goal of \$485,000 with a final amount of \$560,170. This excess helped us complete the end of year projects.
- We moved our parish checking account to a higher interest account, increasing our interest rate from 0.26% to 3.1%. Our money is working better for us.

I hope all of this good news will help you have a good week!

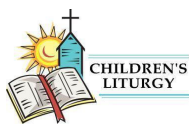
