

"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

St. James speaks very clearly and strongly to us in the Epistle this Sunday: "Beloved, where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there is disorder and every foul practice. But the wisdom from above is first of all pure, then peaceable, gentle, compliant, full of mercy and good fruits, without inconstancy or insincerity. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace for those who cultivate peace. Where do the wars and where do the conflicts among you come from? Is it not from your passions that make war within your members? You covet but do not possess. You kill and envy but you cannot obtain; you fight and wage war. You do not possess because you do not ask. You ask but do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions." challenged in these admonishments in the scriptures, and perhaps you are as well. There is a tough honesty in his challenge for us to examine our lives and to ask the difficult questions. Are the places in my life where I am unhappy or unsatisfied from my own comparisons or expectations? Where I seek fidelity and peace, am I not more often than not in peace with myself? Can we ask God first and foremost to help us see things from His point of view before making judgments and comparisons? If my first thoughts are of good for another and not comparison and gossip, will I not more often live in peace? Certainly, St. James offers challenges for each of us today.

I will be out of the office this upcoming week on my annual hiking trip, this year to the Sawtooth Mountain Range in Idaho. Right now they are dealing with some smoke issues from nearby wildfires, so I hope to come back and report some beautiful mountains with clear skies. I will see you next weekend.


