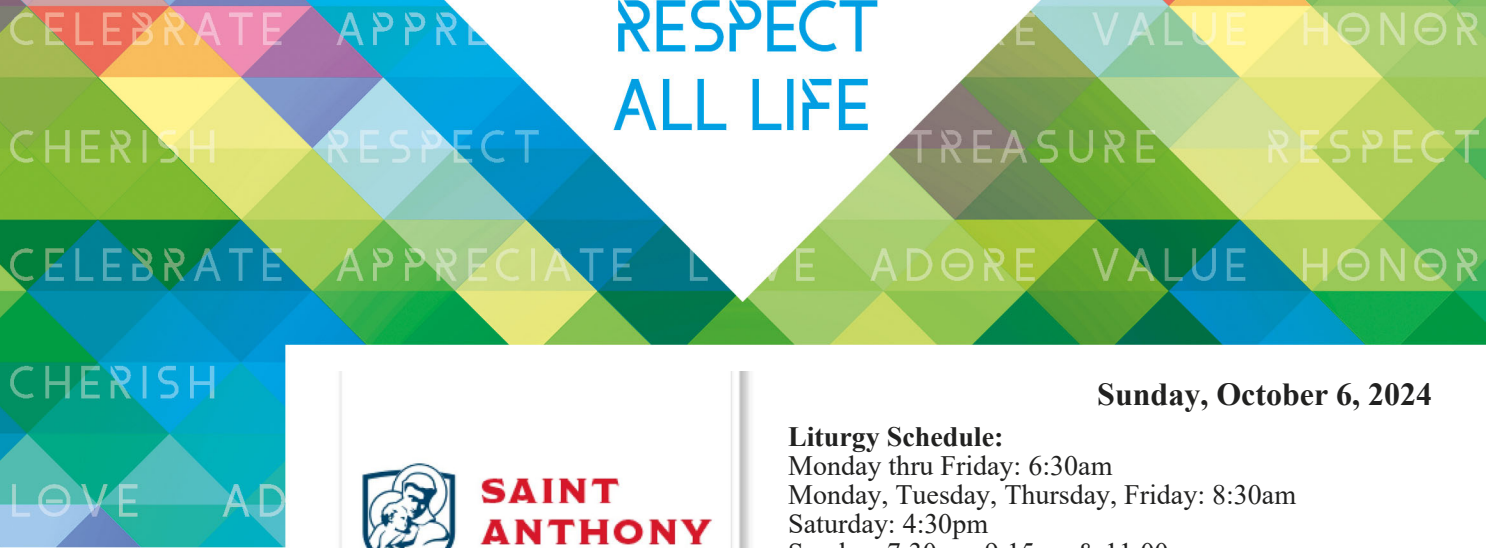

“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

This Sunday we reflect on our readings from Sacred Scripture focused on God’s creation, both its beauty and his intention in creating all of it and all of us. It is a reminder of a basic truth of our Catholic faith which is, though timeless and unchanging, unfortunately being called into question in our broader culture: God created us in His own image and likeness, male and female, and the faithful living out of the married vocation is an exclusive and permanent gift of self of man to woman and woman to man. It is only in this union, that life is given in accord with God’s design.

We should not be deterred from the proclamation of this truth, even though living it can be a challenge. We are not called to be like everyone else, we are called to live in accord with God’s plan. Reassigning one’s gender, chemically or surgically, re-defining marriage, living intimately with someone who is not our married partner... while these may become accepted or even lauded as an expression of freedom, will not bring us lasting satisfaction. While the dignity of every person, no matter their struggles or attraction, is without question, so is the call to live a life in accord with God’s plan. The deterioration of our culture around us is not something in which we delight, but rather reminds us that living in accord with God’s plan is the only way in which we have peace and fulfillment.

You will notice that during this past week the parking lot south of St. Louis Avenue was repaired. Over the last few years, the lot became broken and uneven in places due to some underground instability. This became a safety issue which needed to be addressed before the lot deteriorated further and cause a safety issue. Those areas were filled and compacted and new concrete was set to give us an even and safe surface.

I pray you have a blessed week.
