“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

We are blessed to have a vibrant ministry to the homebound and those who are in care facilities. Fr. Jayke and I make visits to those who are homebound and unable to come to Sunday Mass on or near the first Friday of every month. There are many volunteers to take communion to residences and to their family members who also cannot come to Mass. We are grateful for their giving of their time to this ministry. But we always seek to search out those who still might be in need of coming into contact with the Lord in Holy Communion on a regular basis.

If you are reading this and either are yourself unable to leave where you live to come to Mass at St. Anthony, or know of a loved one, neighbor or friend, who is in this situation, please contact our office so that we can come to see them at least once a month. We are happy to do so, and this sacramental contact means so much to people who miss being with their parish community.

At the same time, we are also in need of additional volunteers to help us in this ministry. We are happy to explain how this ministry takes place and will demonstrate what needs to happen when you take communion to the homebound or in to residences. This is a very fulfilling ministry which will allow you to make someone’s day! It is a Corporal Work of Mercy to visit the sick. I hope you might be willing to consider this outreach which will strengthen someone’s connection to St. Anthony when they depend on it.

With the sad news of the severe flood damage in the Southeastern United States in recent weeks and in Florida these past days, we urge you to be generous in helping fund their recovery. Should you wish to pool your gifts with others from St. Anthony, we will collect them and forward them to a reputable charity, such as Catholic Charities USA, as we get them.
