

"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family

Last week we introduced the concept that our nation's democracy is founded upon and depends upon higher universal principles for all mankind. This week I hope to show some points which help us see the mindfulness of God present in our nation's founding documents.

In a visit to the United States, St. John Paul II spoke: "...of your founding documents: the Declaration of Independence, the Constitution and Bill of Rights...these documents are grounded in and embody unchanging principles of the natural law whose permanent truth and validity can be known by reason, for it is the law written by God in human hearts."

For more than an individualist liberty, our nation was founded upon a deeper and higher good. "There is a liberty of corrupt nature, which is affected both by men and beasts to do what they wish, but there is a civil, moral and federal liberty, which is the proper end and object of authority; it is a liberty for that only which is just and good." (from the Mayflower Compact)

Pope Benedict wrote: "The principles governing political and social life are intimately linked to a moral order based on the dominion of God the Creator." The destiny of which our Founding Fathers spoke was clear: to rely on God as the giver of our rights and dignity. The leaders of our nation throughout our history, at least-sadlyuntil recently, spoke with the conviction that the success of the United States is part of God's plan, that it be a convincing example of freedom and human fulfillment. That success requires that we ourselves work to defend the rights and dignity of persons in accord with God's plan.

In this time before Election Day, we should implore the Lord to guide our actions, lest we forget how our nation was conceived and what good it is called to do.
