"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

I pray that this week of Christmas is a blessing to you and your family. I realize that it is a busy time for everyone, and that it can be hard to focus on the real reason for all that we do. I hope that you may be able at some point this week to pause and ask God to give you the peace and joy that this celebration of His nearness offers us. More than anything else, God desires us to know that we are not alone; His love in Christ is meant to envelop and sustain us. If you have a friend or family member attend Mass at Christmas who may not usually come regularly, this can be a great opportunity....you can gently invite them to the place where the Incarnate God is known each week in the Eucharist!

At the Masses next weekend, December 28-29, we will be placing a special focus on the Crisis Nursery here in Effingham. We started this last year, and it was met with great success. One of the members of their staff will speak briefly at the beginning of Mass and there will be an informational sheet in the bulletin with an opportunity to assist their mission. If you are not familiar with their work, I ask you to be open to assisting. They work to provide assistance to mothers and families who have a sudden need for help for their children from birth to six years old. They are licensed and work in conjunction with HSHS St. Anthony Hospital. Their shelter is open 24 hours a day and they offer care free of charge. I asked them to come on the week of the Feast of the Holy Family, to solicit support from us, remembering that the family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph found themselves in need and relying on the help of others. They travelled to a town with no room in the inn and they fled to Egypt to avoid Herod. I am proud of the good work our community does to save children from a hortion, and we also must offer assistance to method; in panel to continue our problem in the property has from abortion, and we also must offer assistance to mothers in need to continue our pro-life mission. This nursery has saved children from the unfortunate results which crisis and struggle can bring to families in need. I ask you to be attentive to them and to be supportive.

Just a reminder that our normal schedule of weekday Mass is adjusted. There are no morning Masses on Tuesday December 24 or Thursday December 26 and only the 6:30 a.m. on Friday December 27. This allows us to have some down time to celebrate Christmas. Thanks for your understanding.
