#### "From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

St. Paul reminds us in our Second Reading today that we are each given different gifts from God, but that they all come from the same Holy Spirit and are to be used for building up each other and our relationships with God, no matter where we find ourselves. When I hear these words, I think of the grace of generosity and humility which are needed to properly use these gifts for God's purpose. It can be very easy to see our gifts, but not appreciate the gifts which others have; especially if they are different from our own. We can also be tempted at times to not share our gifts, or we can give in to a spirit of competition or comparison which fails to recognize two important things: they all come from God and therefore we have no real reason to brag or compare; and, that while they may be different in kind and degree, they neither increase or reduce our dignity or the dignity of others. Hearing these words from St. Paul this weekend, let us take to our daily prayer the desire for both generosity and humility in our dealings with each other.

We have been journeying this past fall and winter with several candidates for Baptism and Full Communion in the Catholic Faith through the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, (OCIA). It appears that at our Easter Vigil, we will have five adults and two school children to initiate into the faith. You may have recognized them at the 9:15 a.m. Masses on Sundays, as they gather with us before their weekly catechesis. But beginning on Sunday March 2, with their Rite of Entrance and then with the various Scrutinies each week, you will see them as a group, leading up to their Baptism and/or Full Initiation with Confirmation and Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil April 19. Please begin praying for them on their journey. I want to thank Deacon Joe Emmerich, Jessie Davis and Fr. Jayke, who have been helping me teach them each week.

With Monday being the Inauguration Day of a new Administration for our Federal Government, please keep President Trump and all those who lead us in your prayers. May the Holy Spirit enlighten and guide them to work for that which is just, righteous and peaceable! Have a blessed week! Stay warm!


