“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

You will note, as an insert in this week’s bulletin, the details regarding our fiscal planning for the 2025-2026 school year. In consultation with the diocesan suggestions for the 2025-2026 school year, we are happy to announce that, with the input and recommendation of our Finance Council, we have approved a 3% salary increase school faculty for the 2025-2026 school year. Faculty will receive a 1.9% step in addition to the 3.0% as in years past. We are aware that the reality of inflation has caused the cost of living to increase for all of us. We believe it is necessary to support our high-quality teachers and staff in a time when we are experiencing a teacher shortage in the state of Illinois and reliable, hard-working support staff are in great demand. To be able to accomplish this, tuition rates will increase 3.9% for the 2025-2026 school year. Some points on those number will be helpful:

We are blessed that the above numbers are equal with regard to salary increase from last year, but lower for tuition increases. Additionally, we have increased the subsidy which our faculty and staff receive for the tuition for their own families. We consider very carefully the calculation to balance the needed salary increase with its effect on tuition. Happily, this past year we were able to absorb the costs associated with the elimination of the monies previously received through the Invest in Kids Act without losing any students. The good news continues, in that as our very successful “Securing our Future” Campaign for the St. Anthony Educational Trust continues to be funded fully by the five year pledges in the next years, the annual contributions to the schools’ budget will continue to grow!

Please remember that our other means of support for our schools, including our Annual Fund and your regular contributions to the parish make it possible to offer a larger increase to salary than increase to tuition. We are blessed to be in such a position that we can make these changes in this manner.

I pray you have a blessed week, I will be enjoying the warmth and quiet of St. Kitts this week with some classmates from the seminary.

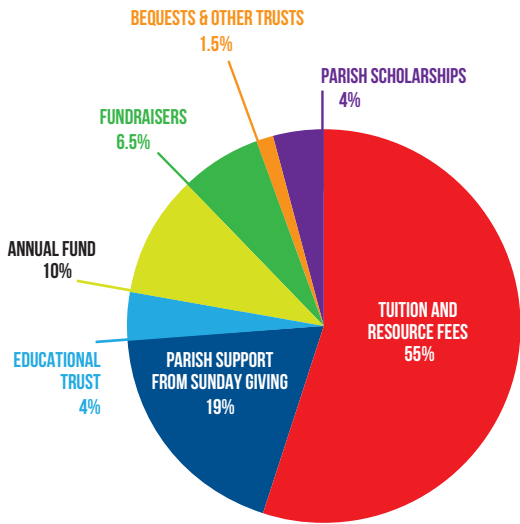

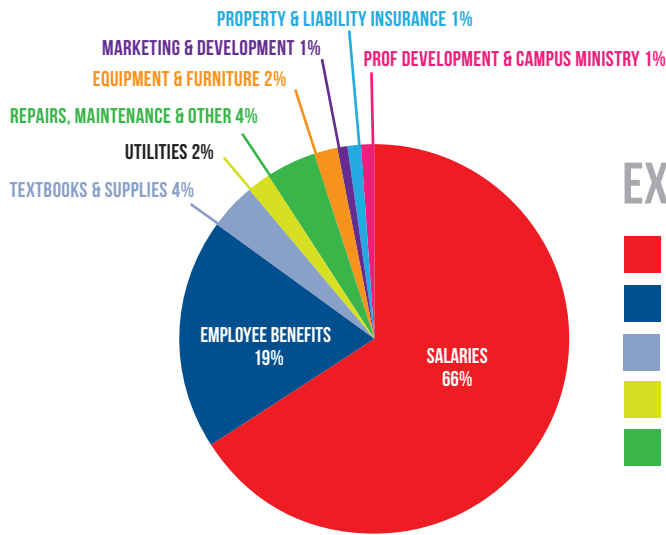

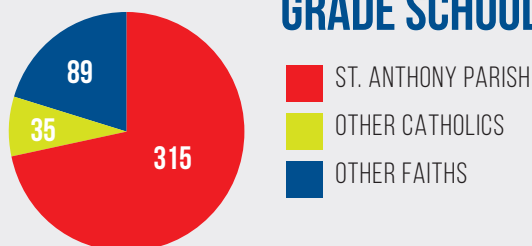

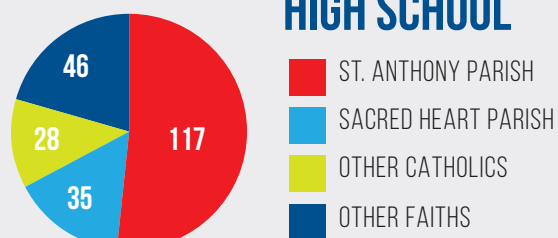
STUDENT POPULATION BREAKDOWN



GRADE SCHOOL



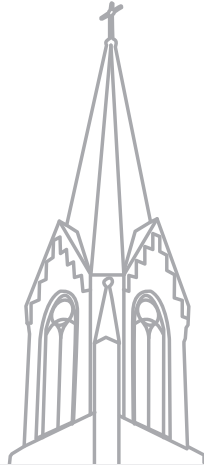

The tradition of the St. Anthony Parish Picnic has greatly benefited St. Anthony Schools for more than 50 years.



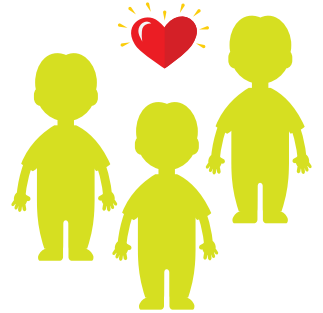
5 EDUCATIONAL TRUST
