"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

A reminder that as I wrote last week, on Wednesday February 19 I am scheduled to undergo hip surgery in Springfield. This will entail my being "off work" for at least two full weeks while I recover and I promise to do my best to both rest and exercise as prescribed. I will be staying up to date on things, since my house of recovery is only a few yards from my work, but the staff here has permission to threaten and/or report me if I don't do what I am instructed! You will not likely see me until midweek of March 9, but from then on, I hope to be able to be present and active for Lent, Holy Week and Easter. We are very blessed to have the assistance of Fr. James Flach and Fr. Dean Probst to fill in while I am out of commission. I am told that in 12 weeks, barring any unforeseen complications, I will be able to move and do what I was before this began. I have tried to plan this out so as to be the least disruptive to our parish life. I thank you in advance for your prayers and understanding.

You will notice boxes in the vestibule in the back of Church for collecting Palm Branches. Please bring them in no later than Sunday March 2, so that they can be burned for the Ashes we will use on Ash Wednesday March 5.

Though later this year, Lent is on the horizon! Ash Wednesday is March 5. Beginning the next week, March 12, each Wednesday will offer us a time of prayer, formation and reflection:

- 6:30 a.m. Mass followed by Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament
- Confessions will be heard from 12:00 to 1:00 p.m.
- Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 5:15 p.m. followed by Mass
- Light supper provided in the Parish Hall followed by our Catechetical Series: "The Last Seven Words of Christ"
 - ♦ March 12: "Father, forgive them, they know not what they do." (Luke 23:34)
 - ♦ March 19: "Woman, behold, your son...Son, behold, your mother" (John 19:26-27)
 - March 26: "Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise." (Luke 23:43) and "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Matthew 27:46)




