"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

As we get to this point in the summer, besides wondering where it has gone, we look to upcoming things in the calendar for your consideration in strengthening your spiritual life. We are in the midst of reviewing the spiritual offerings we have going on in the parish, the prayer and scripture groups already in progress. We will be preparing a handout for you to keep handy, which will show the opportunities for the 2025-2026 year.

I wanted to preview two new things for you, in addition to the offerings which will start up again in the fall:

We will offer a 3-part series on devotion to Mary through the rosary. This is a very well-done program from the same group who organizes the "That Man Is You" Series of which the men of the parish partake on Friday mornings. This will give new life to your praying of the rosary, no matter how long you have done this. It will be offered between the morning Masses on Mondays (7:15-8:15 a.m.) to allow those who attend either of those Masses regularly to participate. The first series will begin Monday September 15. The second will begin after the first of the year and the third after Easter. Please stay tuned!

I will lead a study group on the simple but profound book by Fr. Jacques Philippe "Time for God." It will be a five-week series which will meet on Wednesdays at noon. I envision that each person brings his lunch and we cover the five chapters in his book. This is very doable, as the entire book is only a little over 100 pages. I cannot stress enough that this book is both approachable for the spiritual "novice" and yet profound enough to give each person I have ever offered this book some great reflection. (I have returned to it many times in my own life, only to find things I have not exhausted from the last reading!) We will need to order these books in advance so that we can begin together, the cost of each book is only around \$15.00. Please inform us of your interest, so that we can order together...even if you cannot commit to each week, for even getting started will be a spiritual grace. We will plan on Wednesdays November 5, 12, 19, 26 and December 3.


