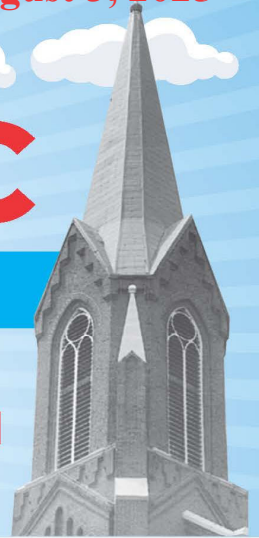

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

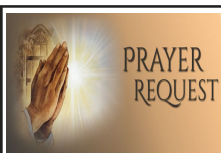

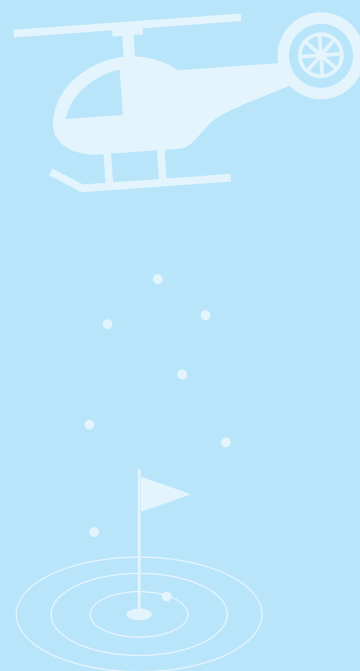
