"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

Thanks to all who help make this picnic weekend the great event that it is. I look forward to greeting you on the high school grounds.

This week we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary into heaven on Friday August 15. This is a Holy Day of Obligation, and our Masses will be as follows: Vigil Mass on Thursday August 14 at 5:30 p.m., and on August 15 at 6:30 a.m. 8:30 a.m. and 12:10 p.m. The Catechism of the Catholic Church helps us identify this reality of Mary's passing from this world into heaven, taking into account that she was prepared without Original Sin (the Immaculate Conception) to bring the sinless Son of God into the world. Both genetically and otherwise, we know in life that "you cannot give what you do not have!" "The Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all state of Original Sin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be the more fully conformed to her Son, the conqueror of sin and death. The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin is a singular participation in her Son's Resurrection and an anticipation of the resurrection of other Christians." (CCC 966) We hope to be what she already is! She does not need to wait to be redeemed from sin. Our redemption only comes through the Christ she bore for us.

Since this was such a great evening last year, I want to invite you to come and pray with the new St. Anthony High School class as they begin their first day with Orientation on Monday August 11. This is something that we started in recent years, that in addition to the details of orienting them for life at St. Anthony High School, we wish to make it time of prayer together: that they may call upon God's help from the very first day to unite them as a class and bless their experience as high school students. We have every reason to be proud of the High School, but we must not forget that it exists first and foremost for the handing down of the faith. Their day will conclude with prayer and Benediction in the evening, from around 6:45 pm. to 7:30 p.m. in St. Anthony Church. Would you come and show your solidarity with them as they begin the year, and pray that God would bless and protect them, guiding them in the faith? Please consider doing so.

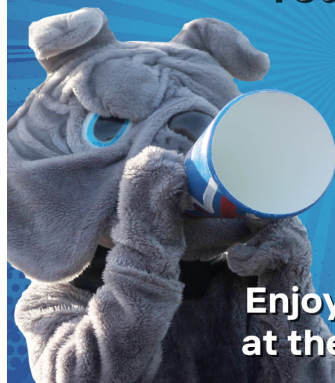

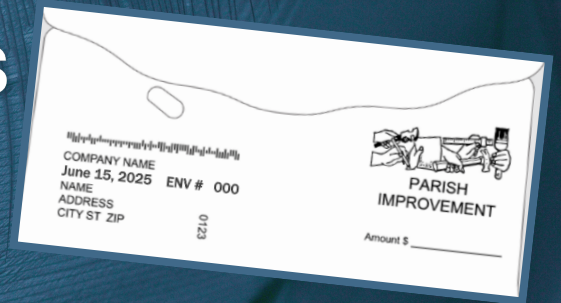
