"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

This Sunday we have the blessing of having the Feast of the Exultation of the Cross commemorated as our Sunday Mass. Our Gospel provides us with some of the most beautiful words in Scripture: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him." St. John was blessed to be inspired to write down this revelation from himself being under the Cross of Christ. In the mystery of the Cross of Christ we find victory in the midst of suffering, the promise of life in the midst of death. Bishop Robert Baron has so beautifully said that Catholics honor the cross and show the crucified Christ with pride and love. For instead of seeing it as defeat, (why would you show this happening to the Christ you love?) we show it as both the depth of His love and the power that He is victorious even over this! In other words, since He was victorious over the worst thing a human being can do to another human being, the crucifixion; we have nothing to fear, our God is victorious over everything!

This week the priests of the diocese gather together for our annual clergy convocation. It will be held at the Augustine Institute in St. Louis from Monday afternoon through Thursday afternoon, September 15-18. It is one of the few times that all of the priests are able to gather together, and in fact we are expected to do so. It is the only time of the year where we are all gathered together for any significant time. In addition to the topics which are presented for our continued theological education, the time to share in fraternity with the other priests of the diocese is a real blessing. For this reason, and this is the only time of the year where both Fr. Jayke and I will be away, there will not be daily Mass Tuesday through Thursday, but will begin again on Friday September 19.


