"From the Pastor's Desk"

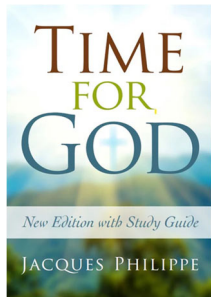
Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

**Time for God**

"I would like to pray, but don't have the time or know how to start out." Does that sound familiar? It is not uncommon to feel unequipped for prayer or how to best follow up with the inspiration we have to draw closer to God. Fr. Jacques Philippe in his classic book *Time for God*, offers a profound yet approachable guide for deepening our sense of God's presence. This fall, Fr. Harman will lead the discussion in a five-part series, with the help of a study guide, through this book. It will take place over the lunch hour, noon-1 p.m., on the Wednesdays of November 5 - December 3. The readings are manageable, since the whole book is just over 100 pages, but it will require some time of reading each week to be able to benefit from the presentation and discussion. 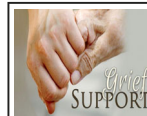

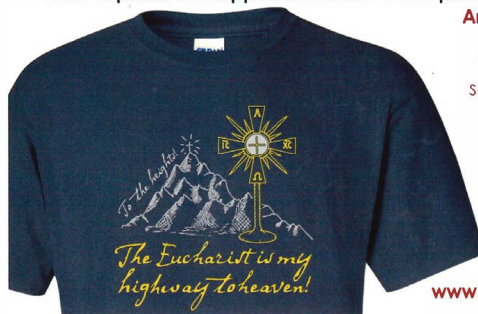
