"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

Jesus teaches a very challenging lesson with his parable for today's Gospel. There is a wide difference between the Pharisee and the tax collector. The lesson is about the difference between righteousness and self-righteousness. The Lord calls us to have the good deeds of the Pharisee, but without the comparison and self-righteousness. He calls us to have the humility of the tax collector, but to be honest and righteous. He calls us to root out judgment and gossip, the things which lead to division. He calls us to be strong in deeds, but humble in attitude. We know this balance requires grace, something for which we must all pray regularly.

You should have received the mailing for the 2025-2026 Annual Fund. I urge you to accept the "Pastor's Challenge" whereby we both make a gift of \$1000.00, or more. I can say "humorously": I don't even have kids in the school, but I am happy to make this sacrifice for those who do. Will you join me?

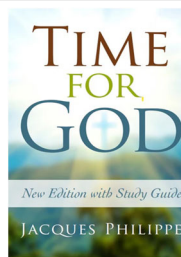

Sacrament of Marriage

Please contact our parish office at least 9 months before your anticipated wedding date to begin your spiritual preparation. The process will begin with meeting with one of our priests to set your date. One or both persons must be **registered** and **actively** living their faith at St. Anthony Church for at least 1 year to celebrate their wedding here. All couples planning to be married at our parish must attend a Pre-Cana program, Natural Family Planning program, and FOCCUS evaluation. Former members here must be **registered** and **actively** living their faith at the parish where they reside. The latest a wedding can begin is 1pm.



Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated during Mass on Saturdays & Sundays (not during Lent). A family must be **registered & actively** living their faith at St. Anthony Church for 1 year to assure the faith will be shared with the newborn child. 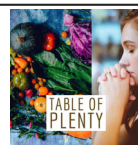

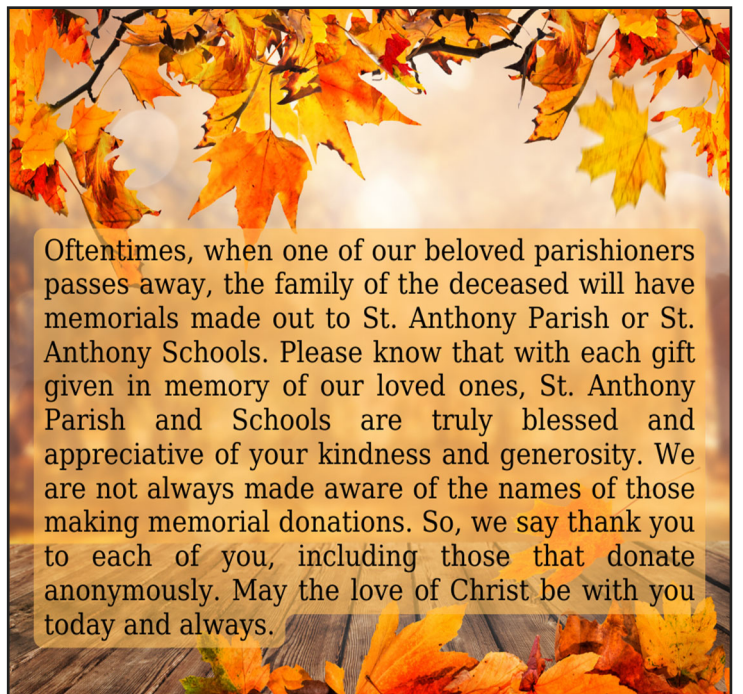

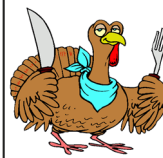
