

### "From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

All Souls' Day falls on our Sunday calendar this year. A great tradition of our Catholic faith is to never forget the lives of those who have gone before us. We do that in a two-part commemoration: November 1 is the celebration of the saints already in heaven, some of which are officially canonized and recognized for their sanctity and their involvement in being intercessors for us; and November 2 being All Soul's Day, whereby we specifically offer to God the lives of those whom we trust are on their way to heaven if not there yet.

The Church's teaching on the afterlife is a real treasure which incorporates what God has revealed and what we also sense from our human experience. While some have misunderstandings about the notion of Purgatory, it is worth reflecting that the perfection promised in heaven, actually requires a type of preparation after we die. Our belief is that heaven is the experience of being caught up in and brought into the very love and being of God Himself. At the funeral Mass we profess "we will enjoy the fullness of your glory, when you will wipe away every tear from our eyes. For seeing you, our God, as you are, we shall be like you for all the ages and praise you without end!"

I don't know about you, but even on my best day, I am not yet ready to enter into that glory and perfection. I rejoice at the notion of a time of purification, not punishment, but being made ready for perfection, being taught so as to understand the language of heaven. I know I will have to be enlightened to understand things yet unknown to me, not yet ready to comprehend. I know I will have to see things to be fully aware of God's ever provident love in my life, sometimes unknown. I know I will have to be forgiven for things I maybe never even knew or intended. I imagine I will have to say "I forgive" for those whose entrance into heaven, as well as my own, requires a peace not yet reached. In other words, I know I am not yet ready for heaven, because if I, or anyone else, brings in something not yet made whole, not yet forgiven, not yet at peace, then that reality no longer is heaven! Heaven is not just a better version of today, it is the life for which we are made for eternity. Lord, make me ready!

I am very much looking forward to the start of our study of Fr. Jacques Philippe's "Time for God" on Wednesday. Over 55 parishioners have signed up, and the books are ready for you to pick up in the office. We will begin at noon, so please bring something for your lunch if you wish.




