The Dedication of th Gateran Basilica

"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

The 2025 Calendar has afforded us some unique Sunday Celebrations, in that certain Feasts have fallen on a Sunday, where we would have normally celebrated another week of Ordinary Time. It will not happen again until 2031. Sometimes it is a longer interval due to leap years. The Presentation of the Lord, February 2 fell on a Sunday. Saints Peter and Paul, June 29 did as well. In September, the Exultation of the Cross, September 14 fell on a Sunday. Last week we Commemorated All Souls on Sunday November 2. This week, the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome displaces what would be the 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time. Why does this celebration mean so much on our Catholic Calendar as to "take over" our Sunday? How about a little history and perspective?

The Lateran Basilica, officially called Sant' Giovvanni in Laterano, translated the Basilica of St. John in the Lateran, is dedicated to both St. John the Baptist and the Apostle St. John. It is the Cathedral of the Diocese of Rome. (Not St. Peter's Basilica. St. Peter's Basilica is actually the Cathedral for the Pope as the Universal Bishop of the entire Church, not as his role of Bishop of Rome.) It sits on the former palace of the Laterani family. The Emperor Constantine, who legalized Christianity in the Roman Empire married into this family, and was given this palace, which he then gave to the Church for the Successor St. Peter, the Pope to live. What a turn of events! The popes who had previously been martyred for trying to lead the Christian people when their faith was illegal, were now recognized with dignity. So, this celebration marks a point for the Church being able to be freely governed and live in society.

This celebration ought to cause each of us to pause and give thanks for the presence of the Church, both its physical being as a beautiful structure and house of God, as well as its membership, to which you and I have an important role. Perhaps it could also be an opportunity to pray for our continued protection of religious liberty and expression in our society. May we never take this for granted.
