## **ACTION ALERT**

# Please ask Governor Pritzker to VETO SB 1950 – Legalizing Assisted Suicide

At 2:54 a.m. on October 31<sup>st</sup>, the Illinois State Senate narrowly passed SB 1950. The State House narrowly passed the bill in the spring. The bill is now on the governor's desk.

This is the last chance to stop assisted suicide from becoming law in Illinois.

In Canada, 1 in 20 deaths are now due to assisted suicide/euthanasia, which has been legal since 2016. Too many are giving up on life under this law.

## PLEASE INFORM GOVERNOR PRITZKER:

- People with disabilities, the poor, and the marginalized fear coercion and abuse under assisted suicide laws.
- Suicide rates increase in states where assisted suicide is legal, especially among veterans.
- There are documented cases of patients being denied treatment and instead offered life-ending drugs in states where this is legal.


