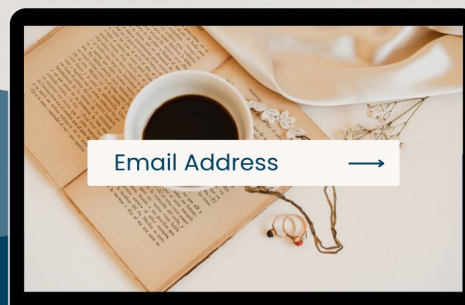
The cost is \$200 by Dec 1, with the balance \$200 by Jan 1. Partial scholarships are available.

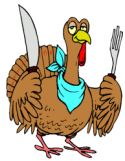

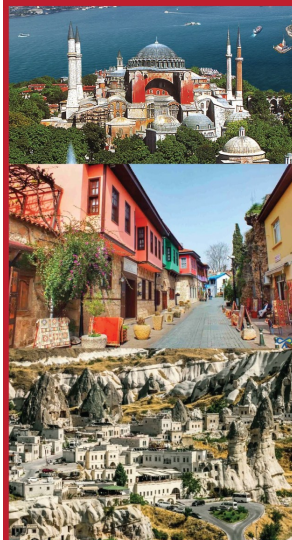
