Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

A reminder of our Advent Spiritual Opportunities starting now!

- * Starting this week and for three Wednesdays of Advent, December 3, 10 and 17: 5:15 p.m. Weekday Mass followed by presentation in the Parish Center. This year's theme, the Virtues of Faith, Hope and Love in Advent and Christmas Art. I think you will find this interesting. It follows the format we have used in recent years for Lent and Advent.
- * Sunday December 7: Parish Christmas Caroling. Depart Parish Center at 1 p.m. This is a wonderful experience, especially for children. We go to the homebound and brighten their season.
- * Sunday December 14: Advent Penance Service at 3 p.m. in church.
- * Sunday December 21: Advent Lessons and Carols at 4 p.m. This brief prayer service will allow us to hear the short scripture which inspires so many of our beautiful Advent and Christmas Carols and then sing them together in prayer. This is a beautiful service.

Next Monday, December 8 is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses will be celebrated on Monday only (since Sunday is a Sunday of Advent) 6:30 a.m., 8:30 a.m., 12:10 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.
