

"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

Our Gospel for this weekend tells us that "John the Baptist appeared, preaching in the desert of Judea and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" It was of him that the prophet Isaiah had spoken when he said:

A voice of one crying out in the desert, *Prepare the way of the Lord,* make straight his paths.

At that time Jerusalem, all Judea, and the whole region around the Jordan were going out to him and were being baptized by him in the Jordan River as they acknowledged their sins."

That is quite a statement, that *all* of Judea went to John and acknowledged their sins! Can we come in trust to Jesus to have our sins forgiven in the Sacrament of Reconciliation this Advent? Can we be renewed so as to celebrate Christmas with greater peace and joy? Can we...will we? I would argue that until we are reconciled with each other and with God, we do not carry about in ourselves the Spirit which the Lord desires to provide for us. The first reading from the Prophet Isaiah speaks about how the Spirit of truth can help us to navigate life rightly, "not by appearance shall he judge, nor by hearsay shall he decide, but he shall judge the poor with justice, and decide aright for the land's afflicted." Does our world not need this in its divisions and bitterness? Not to fall victim to judgments, gossip and rumors? Do we not need to be reconciled to truth and peace in our relationships? We provide as a part of the school day the opportunity for our grade school and high school students to do this, and for the whole parish as well! In addition to our regular confession times, we will offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation, next Sunday, December 14 beginning at 3:00 p.m.

Monday, December 8 is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, a holy day of obligation and the Patronal Feast of our Country and our Diocese. Masses will be celebrated Monday only, 6:30 a.m., 8:30 a.m. 12:10 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.
