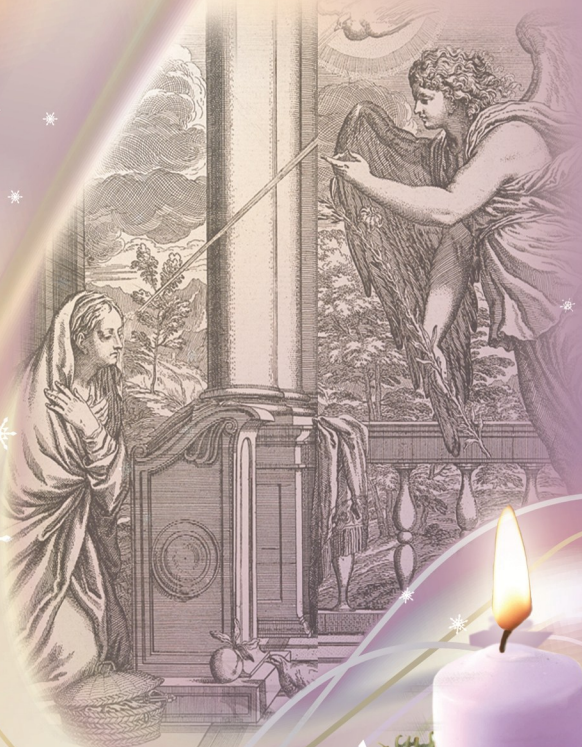

I often hear people say that we only get a few weeks of Mass to sing our favorite Christmas hymns, so this is a chance to hear even more of what moves us.
