

Warm wishes for a safe and happy holiday! Once school resumes, we will be delivering Table of Plenty to "The Study Shoppe." St. Anthony's Jr. High students are asked to bring their donations to morning Mass on Tuesday, January 13, and the elementary students may bring their donations to morning Mass on Thursday, January 15. Parishioners may drop their donations in the church foyer before the weekend Masses on January 17/18. The Study Shoppe, located at 800 Henrietta St. Effingham, (one block from the Effingham Jr. and High School), is a nonprofit that provides a free charge, safe place for students in grades 6-12, to work on their homework assignments. They are fully staffed Monday-Thursday from 3:00-5:00, and are there to assist when help is needed. Concessions are provided through donations like ours. For some, this is the only snack they may have all day, so your generosity is very much appreciated. They are always in need of the following: Full Size Candy Bars, All Little Debbie Type Snack Cakes, Full Sized Bags of Microwave Popcorn, and Individual Bags of Potato Chips and Snacks. Variety Packs are Welcome. Understandably, we are not asking St. Anthony Students to carry in water, however, if Parishioners are interested in donating small cases of bottled water, they may drop that in the foyer, as well, as each child is provided one, daily with their snack.






