“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

As we commemorate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, I came across a writing of the late Pope Benedict XVI for our reflection: As we heard in Advent, John the Baptist called all of Jerusalem and Judea out to the Jordan River to do two things, confess their sins and be baptized. “The act of descending into the waters of Baptism implies a confession of guilt and a plea for forgiveness in order to make a new beginning. In a world marked by sin, then, this Yes to the entire will of God [by Jesus] also expresses solidarity with men, who have incurred guilt but yearn for righteousness. The significance of the event of Jesus’ baptism could not fully emerge until it was seen in light of the Cross and Resurrection. Descending into the water, the candidates for Baptism confess their sin and seek to be rid of their burden of guilt. What did Jesus do in this same situation?

“St. Luke tells us that Jesus was praying while he was baptized. Looking at the events in light of the Cross and Resurrection, the Christian people realized what happened. Jesus loaded the burden of all mankind’s guilt upon his shoulders; he bore it down into the depths of the Jordan River. He inaugurated his public activity by stepping into the place of sinners. His very first gesture is in anticipation of the Cross. He is, as it were, the new and true Jonah who said to the crew of the ship, ‘Take me and throw me into the sea.’ ”

“The whole significance of Jesus’ baptism, the fact that he bears all righteousness first comes to light in the Cross. The Baptism is an acceptance for the sins of humanity, and the voice that calls out ‘This is my beloved Son’ over the baptismal waters is an anticipation of the victory and vindication of the Resurrection.” Does Jesus not say later, “I have a Baptism to receive and how I long that it were completed?” He says this after his Baptism by John (which we commemorate today), and before going to Jerusalem to offer his life for our sins.

Perhaps today you can give thanks for your own Baptism and your belonging to the Church. Perhaps you can show your little children pictures of their own Baptism and explain what this means in light of what we celebrate today. Happy anniversary of Baptism!



Warm wishes for a safe and happy holiday! Once school resumes, we will be delivering Table of Plenty to "The Study Shoppe." St. Anthony's Jr. High students are asked to bring their donations to morning Mass on Tuesday, January 13, and the elementary students are asked to

bring their donations to morning Mass on Thursday, January 15. Parishioners may drop their donations in the church foyer before the weekend Masses on January 17/18. The Study Shoppe, located at 800 Henrietta St. Effingham, (one block from the Effingham Jr. and High School), is a nonprofit that provides a free charge, safe place for students in grades 6-12, to work on their homework assignments. They are fully staffed Monday-Thursday from 3:00-5:00, and are there to assist when help is needed. Concessions are provided through donations like ours. For some, this is the only snack they may have all day, so your generosity is very much appreciated. They are always in need of the following: Full Size Candy Bars, All Little Debbie Type Snack Cakes, Full Sized Bags of Microwave Popcorn, and Individual Bags of Potato Chips and Snacks. 
Pro-Life Corner




