“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

In a little while we will begin our Lenten Pilgrimage with Ash Wednesday on February 18. Masses with the distribution of Ashes will be at 6:30 a.m., 8:30 a.m., 12:10 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. We will again be providing the “Little Black Books” daily devotional to each household. They will be at the entrances of Church beginning the weekend of February 14-15.

The following Wednesday, February 25 starts our first Lenten Devotional day.

- 6:30 a.m. - Parish Mass ending with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament all day
Noon to 1:00 p.m. Confessions heard in Church
- 5:15 p.m. - Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, with Mass to follow
- 6:00 p.m. - Soup/Light Meal in Parish Hall with presentation to follow

These Wednesday sessions have been well received in recent years. They will be from February 25 through March 25. The topic for 2026 will be “Experiencing the Paschal Mystery through the Lives of Those Walking with Jesus.” We will offer a weekly reflection of how the Apostles, Mary and friends of Jesus lived the Cross and Resurrection and what that means for disciples today. I think you will find this a unique perspective for your Lenten reflections. We will also have the sign-ups for the Adoration slots at the West and rear entrances of Church.

Next weekend, February 7-8, Father Doug Grandon will be visiting our parish on behalf of Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS). Fr. Doug is a FOCUS National Chaplain and a priest of the Archdiocese of Denver. FOCUS does great work around the country in evangelizing College students on university campuses, and he will be here to speak about their good and necessary work and how we can help advance it.

We are pleased to share the Finance Council has approved our recommendation for a 5% salary increase for all employees for the 2026–2027 school year, along with an additional 1.9% step increase for faculty. For the second consecutive year, we have been able to plan for salary increases that exceed diocesan recommended rates. These increases reflect two key considerations. First, like many organizations, our diocesan benefits have experienced significant cost increases affecting both employer and employee contributions. This salary adjustment is intended to help offset the impact of rising premiums. Second, we continue to monitor regional public school union contracts to remain competitive. With the public schools' benefit costs rising sharply, we are pleased to report that our combined salary and benefits package now falls within 90% of the public schools in our area.

I will be stepping away later this week from the parish for a ten day cruise in the Caribbean. I will return on Sunday February 15.






Table of Plenty
