“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

In our Gospel for this Sunday in the Octave of Easter and also known as Divine Mercy Sunday, St. Thomas identifies the continual challenge to believe when he objects to the Disciples’ testimony of seeing the risen Lord: “Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nailmarks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe.” St. John continues:

“Now a week later his disciples were again inside and Thomas was with them. Jesus came, although the doors were locked, and stood in their midst and said, “Peace be with you.” Then he said to Thomas, “Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe.” Thomas answered and said to him, “My Lord and my God!” Jesus said to him, “Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed.”

You and I are counted among those that the Lord calls “Blessed”! We all realize the challenges that active and sincere belief in God brings. But if it did not, what worth would it have? If it does not challenge our decisions and make us think twice about the choices we make in life, then what value does it have, or what difference would it make? In truth, it is not a sign of weakness when faith is hard, it is a sign that we are trying to do the right thing in life, and in a conflicted world. What is essential is that we never give up, or ever sideline our faith from the rest of our lives. Perhaps we can pray for St. Thomas’ intercession this week to seek Jesus always and to be willing to be led where He desires and needs us.

You have no doubt heard the news from the week before last of the approval to move Archbishop Fulton Sheen to the status of “Blessed” on his way to hopeful sainthood. This step of Beatification will take place in St. Louis on September 24. How exciting to have this historic moment so close to home!
