*“From the Pastor’s Desk”*

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

We rejoice in the gift of the Eucharist and Confirmation which 46 of our third graders received this weekend, Saturday, May 2, at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Springfield. I want to thank their parents, sponsors, teachers and catechists from our St. Anthony School and Parish School of Religion for making this preparation a priority for them in their lives of faith. You will notice that each family has a banner on the ends of the pews in Church to commemorate this joyful event. May they always be drawn to the Eucharist as their strength and may the Holy Spirit strengthen, inspire, and lead them always! Congratulations and welcome to the altar and banquet of Christ’s living presence!

I am very grateful for your concern and prayers in a recent health episode. I can try to recap it for you: I awoke April 9 with sudden and fairly severe pain which more or less immobilized the area of my right hip and thigh. (not the one which was successfully replaced last February!) It left me unable to sleep, stand, or walk without pain. Trying to “work through it” for a week did not work. I went through an exhaustive series of tests in Springfield starting April 17 which fortunately eliminated major concerns of skeletal, muscular, nerve, or infectious causes, but which unfortunately left me with no diagnosis. The plan of action since my return to the parish April 22 has been pain management, steroid therapy, and physical therapy. As a person who is always on the move, this sudden dependence upon assistance has been a test of patience for sure! I am grateful for your prayers and understanding; and I trust that you know I will get to, and be about, whatever this allows me to do, until, please God, all is normal again.

In the midst of this issue, we also informed you last weekend that Fr. Jayke will be having a change in assignment to become the Parochial Vicar of Christ the King Parish in Springfield, and chaplain at Sacred Heart Griffin High School. On the parish level, this will certainly be a loss for us, as Fr. Jayke has thrown himself into ministry here at St. Anthony with joy and energy, from which we have benefited greatly. On a personal level, he has been a delight to live and work with as a brother priest. I feel blessed to have lived here now with both he and Fr. Michael Berndt, and feel that we have made some good teams for St. Anthony. We will have the chance before Fr. Jayke moves on July 8 to thank him and wish him well. We will look forward to welcoming Fr. Alex McCullough, ordained with Fr. Jayke two years ago, to our St. Anthony family.
