“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

As we celebrate the Ascension of our Lord this weekend, we look to the climax of the Easter Season next week and Pentecost. I ask you to reflect on this reality of our faith this week. Mary and the Apostles spent the time between the Ascension and Pentecost in prayer in the Upper Room. See the Acts of the Apostles, Chapter 1: 12-14. They spent this time awaiting the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Might you spend time this week in prayer before we celebrate Pentecost next weekend asking God to make you aware of where you need the strength, wisdom, courage and faith to be an even more faithful and joyful disciple?
