“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

St. Anthony Cemetery has served as the peaceful and beautiful final resting place for our loved ones of St. Anthony and Sacred Heart Parishes since 1854. Its perpetual care and maintenance are overseen by a board of volunteers from both parishes with the funds collected in the sale of burial plots and donations from each parish in multiple collections throughout the year.


While owning significant acreage, the currently developed portions of the cemetery will reach capacity within the next few years. The St. Anthony Cemetery Committee created this expansion project to level the ground, provide a new access road directly to the North of the currently developed sections, and begin pouring concrete runners for new plots. This addition will provide upwards of 1,500 plots, which amounts to over 38 years of burials. Looking even farther into the future, we own enough land to develop an additional 2,000 plots when needed.

This construction expense estimated at \$100,000 is considered an extraordinary one, in comparison to the funds collected for the cemetery’s perpetual care and maintenance. We are therefore asking for your prayerful consideration of this need as a shared expense between St. Anthony and Sacred Heart Parishes. This is a concrete act of charity in accord with the Corporal Work of Mercy to Bury the Dead. Our local community does a wonderful job in showing respect for our deceased ancestors in the care of St. Anthony Cemetery. We believe that this project will allow us to do so well into the future. Both parishes will offer visual descriptions of the proposed plans at Church. You may use the envelopes or the QR code to make a contribution.

Monday, May 25, we will celebrate Mass at St. Anthony Cemetery for Memorial Day at 9:30 a.m. Should the weather be poor, we will celebrate Mass in St. Anthony Church. There are not other Masses that day.

EXPANSION GOALS

Founded in 1857 (before a Catholic church opened its doors in Effingham) St. Anthony Cemetery has long served as a place of rest for the faithful of St. Anthony of Padua and Sacred Heart. Now, as the developed grounds near their limit, the cemetery must grow to continue its mission, entrusting this next step to the shared, prayerful care of both parish communities.

While St. Anthony Cemetery owns significant additional acreage, the developed portions of the cemetery will **reach capacity within the next few years**. The St. Anthony Cemetery Committee created this expansion project to level the ground, provide a new access road directly to the North of the currently developed sections, and begin pouring concrete runners for new plots.

Phase 1 of this addition will provide upwards of **1,500 plots**, which amounts to over **38 years of burials**. An additional future 2000 plots would be made available in the currently owned St. Anthony Cemetery property for future phases of development.

The construction expense estimated at \$100,000 is considered an extraordinary one, in comparison to the funds collected for the cemetery's perpetual care and maintenance. We are therefore asking for your prayerful consideration of this need as a shared expense between St. Anthony and Sacred Heart Parishes.
