“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:


I would like to update you regarding the upcoming Funeral Policy Changes for the Diocese of Springfield which will take effect immediately. Most of these are already a part of our procedures at St. Anthony, but there are a few minor adjustments.

“The Vigil is an integral part of the Order of Christian Funerals. The Vigil should not be replaced by the Rosary or other devotions, although these may be done in addition to the Vigil. The Vigil can be offered even without the family for the benefit of the deceased. The Vigil may not take place on the morning of the Funeral Liturgy, nor may the visitation take place in the church on the morning of the Funeral Liturgy. The nature of a vigil is to stay awake and keep watch. This is from the tradition of having someone with the deceased from the time of death until the burial, even throughout the night, accompanying them through their last journey on earth. Neither the Vigil nor the visitation may take place in the church, except for with the permission of the pastor in extenuating circumstances - e.g. so large a number of people is expected that it would overwhelm and exceed the capacity of the funeral home. In this case, the visitation should take place in the narthex or gathering space of the church, if the architecture of the church allows it.” As we do not have such a place, this would be a very extraordinary situation, so we should all be prepared to have visitations take place at the funeral home.

“Words spoken in remembrance of the deceased during any of the funeral rites - Vigil, Funeral Liturgy, or Committal - are to be read by a priest or deacon. The remarks are prepared by a family member and then submitted to the pastor at least three days in advance for approval. They are read by the celebrant or another cleric present at the funeral rites. They are not to be a eulogy, which are words spoken in praise of the deceased. To speak in remembrance is to speak of the faith-life of the person in order to give praise to God.” With these restrictions in mind, it will be our policy for words spoken by a member of the family to take place at the Vigil, the meal, or some other gathering instead of at the Funeral Mass.

A reminder to please plan on joining our gathering to send off Fr. Jayke with our thanks and prayers on the weekend of June 13-14. There will be a reception after the Saturday evening Mass June 13 and coffee and donuts between the Sunday Masses of 9:15 and 11:00 am June 14.
