“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

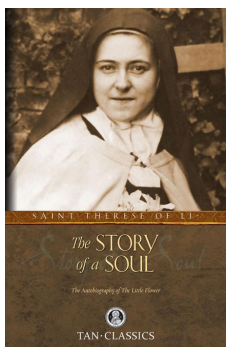
This past weekend, Mr. Joe Sudkamp, who is in the formation process to be ordained a Permanent Deacon, received the ministry of Acolyte at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Springfield with his classmates. This is the last step in his preparation for Ordination, which will take place next June at the Cathedral. Please keep Joe in your prayers and plan to join us next June to celebrate his ordination.

I wanted to update you on a few projects that we are doing during the summer to our buildings. The façade of our Church has large white copings, or caps, made of limestone at the tops of the roofline. We affectionately call them “doghouses.” The ones on the sides of the Church have been replaced with metal caps, but the ones at the top of the façade have not. Over the years, wind and rain and freezing and thawing have taken a toll on them, and from time to time when it is windy, the stucco-like coatings will flake off and fall. This is quite dangerous, as well as not so beautiful. Beginning the week of June 29, you will notice work to replace them and cap them, so that they will be both more beautiful and safer for those of us entering or leaving the Church at the front entrances. The high school is also undergoing renovations to its exterior. After 20+ years of exposure the stucco was showing signs of wear— dents, cracks, failed caulking, and dirt and dampness are being repaired or cleaned. The bricks have also been power washed leaving the whole building feeling renewed. Progress is still ongoing but the high school already looks younger. Go by and take a look. We’re very grateful for the care being given to our building— a care our students will get to appreciate in the upcoming semester.

Please continue to contribute to the St. Anthony Cemetery expansion fund. I am happy to report that we are over the \$50K mark of our portion (66%) of the \$100K goal. You may use the envelopes in the pews and place in the regular Sunday collection or bring to the office.

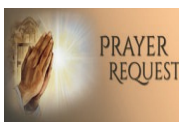
Our Picnic Dinner Chairpersons are on a 3-year rotation. We are looking for volunteers to fill our 3rd chair spot.

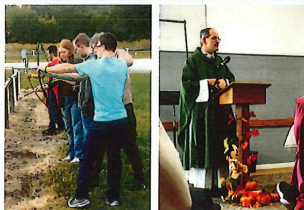
