“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

As I prepare to leave St. Anthony, I want to take a moment to reflect on my time here and offer a word of thanks to all of you. When I was a deacon, preparing to learn where I would first be assigned as a priest, I was only scared of one thing—what if they sent me somewhere with a school? I hadn’t done any school ministry during my time in seminary and I wasn’t sure about the whole idea of it. Well, lo and behold, I ended up at the only parish in the diocese with two schools!

And I fell in love with this place.

During my time here, I’ve been blown away by the blessings God has bestowed on this parish. You may or may not realize it, but St. Anthony has quite possibly the single greatest staff in the entire diocese. The men and women who work in our parish office and schools are some of the most talented, hardworking, and gracious people I’ve met in my entire life. Working alongside them has not only taught me how to better serve God’s people, but how to do so with a heart of love and dedication.

Even more impressive, though, have been the quality of liturgies here at St. Anthony. I don’t say this to inflate my own ego (especially at first, I was the most nervous person in the room during a Sunday mass!). In a particular way, I’ve been stunned by the quality of music in our parish. The ministry of music at St. Anthony aims to elevate the hearts and minds of the faithful to God in prayerful, intentional praise united with the heart of Christ and His Church— this goal is the ideal for any Catholic parish, and we’re blessed enough to find it here! Of course, that’s not to mention our ridiculously talented organists, pianists, cantors, and choirs.


Finally (although I could go on for another 80 pages or so), I want express my gratitude for Fr. Harman. I truly cannot imagine a better first pastor to teach me what it means to be a good, holy priest for God and His people. From excellent meals to excellent pastoral guidance, I really believe that he’s helped shape me into a better priest and a better man.

Please know that, wherever I go, St. Anthony will always be in my heart. You’ve shown me— in your schools, in your liturgies, in your volunteers, and in your pastor—what goodness can look like in a dedicated parish community. May God bless you all, and I ask that you please keep me in your prayers.
