“From the Pastor’s Desk”

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

Last week’s Gospel about Jesus rewarding those who give even a cup of cold water to one who is a disciple allowed me to preach about little cups of water that are spiritual gifts we can give to God and to others. As I don’t expect anybody to remember a list of ten items, I promised to print them for your use. I challenged you that in these hot days where a cup of cold water is small but essential, that at some point this summer you could take these on:

10. Let go of a hurt or grudge.
9. A daily denial of some pleasure. (social media time, complaining, etc)
8. Perform an act of kindness anonymously each week.
7. Come by Church an extra time to say thank you for a blessing.
(We would have no problem coming by to plead that a blessing not be lost!)
6. Receive the Eucharist for someone else’s intention or need.
5. Make a good confession if you have not done so recently.
4. Reach out to a friend, relative or neighbor who is homebound or in a home.
3. Make a true sacrificial gift to a charity. (Yes, we are a charity!)
2. Say “I’m sorry” to someone you have hurt or overlooked or judged.
1. Invite someone who is not here each week to attend Mass with you.

Good luck with these little cups of water that make a difference.

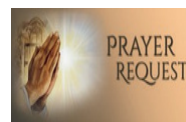


