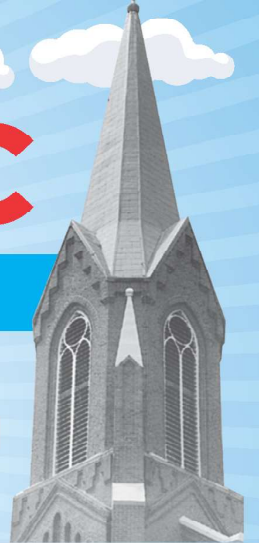

Hello!

My name is Fr. Alex McCullough. I am the new Parochial Vicar here at St. Anthony.

A little about me, I was born and raised my whole life in Mattoon, so I feel like I am getting to come back at least a bit closer to home. I attended Bishop Simon Bruté College Seminary for two years before stepping away from seminary formation for two years. During my interim two years, I lived and worked in Decatur, first doing patient transportation at Decatur Memorial Hospital for a year, before teaching theology at St. Teresa High School for a year. I returned to seminary in 2020, and I attended Saint Meinrad Seminary and School of Theology, where I was classmates with Fr. Jayke. I was ordained a priest in 2024 and I spent two years as the Parochial Vicar at Christ the King in Springfield for my first assignment. At Christ the King, I found a deep love for parish life, especially ministry in the parish school. One of my frequent habits at the school was greeting the students during morning drop-off with my coffee in hand.

I look forward to being able to continue to do the same, when I can, as well as to continue to grow ever more deeply in the Priesthood of Jesus Christ. I am very much looking forward to getting to head over to the high school as well.

At my first Mass of Thanksgiving as a priest, the rector of Saint Meinrad, Fr. Denis Robinson, OSB, told me during his homily to “look out towards the people” as he gestured out to the congregation. This is a line which has stuck with me, and I try to remember it every single day. As I settle in here, I will try my best to remember names, but I may need a little reminder for the first couple months. Last of all, I ask you to please pray for me as well as for Fr. Jayke and all of our priests who are beginning new ministries this month.

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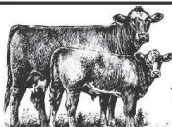
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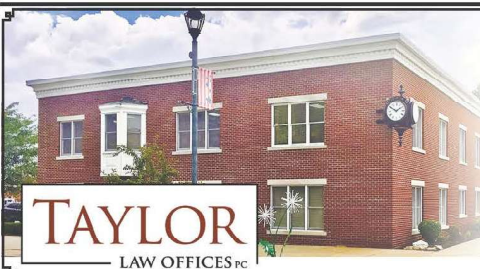
