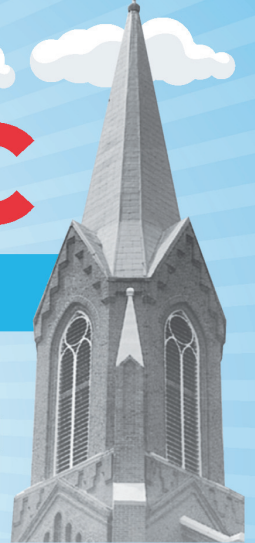

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

I wish to thank you for your generosity both to the St. Anthony Cemetery Expansion Project, which has met its goal, and to the Mission Appeal from the Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary who were here the weekend of July 11-12. I appreciate your dedication and generosity for your parish and the universal Church.

As of this writing, the 10 copings at the top of the façade have been replaced and are in the process of being capped with metal so as to keep the elements from causing them to deteriorate.
