"From the Pastor's Desk"

Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

This Tuesday, August 25, I will be undergoing minor surgery, cubital tunnel in my right elbow, to address a recent issue of numbness in my right hand and fingers. This is a necessary procedure to repair damage from a bicycle injury seven years ago, which has led to arthritis in my right elbow affecting nerve function. I am told that this is a simple and common procedure, which is expected to be successful in restoring feeling and muscle strength to my hand. The major inconvenience will be having my dominant arm in a sling for 14 days, which will preclude my having Mass. I will still be able to be at work shortly after the procedure, but you will most likely not see me publicly. I do ask for your prayers that the surgery be successful and that I have the patience I need to be a good patient during the two week recovery!

We received word recently of the death of Fr. Robert Spriggs. He had been retired and living outside of the diocese for several years. Fr. Spriggs had served both here at St. Anthony (1972-1976) and as Pastor at Sacred Heart (1987-1990 and 2006-2011). Please keep the repose of his soul in your prayers.

You will be seeing the notice of parish support reported differently in the bulletin. It had been our practice to show the previous week's collection and then a comparison to where we are compared to how we have budgeted out the year, which runs from July 1- June 30. But regular giving is no longer done predominantly on a weekly basis. Most give on a monthly basis, and/or give electronically, such that the weekly totals were not the most informative. We will soon be showing the totals for the previous month for all of the Sundays the next month.

Fr Wence from our sister parish in Nigeria will be here in two weeks, September 5 and 6, to give us an update on the good work happening there due to your generous support.

Sacrament of Baptism - Baptisms are celebrated during Mass on Saturdays & Sundays (not during Lent). A family must be registered & actively living their faith at St. Anthony Church for 1 year to assure the faith will be shared with the newborn child. Godparents must be registered in a Catholic parish or a witness registered in a Christian church & actively living their faith. A Baptism Class is required for all parents. 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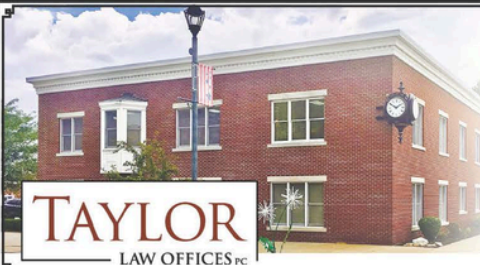
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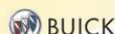
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
