Dear St. Anthony Parish Family:

People are always eager to hear numbers from our recent St. Anthony Parish Picnic. As we still need to finalize payments for the cost of the picnic, we are not able to give you firm numbers for a few weeks. But the attendance and gross receipts are consistent with the very successful picnics we have had the last two years. In particular, the number of Sunday dinners served was up from previous years. We were blessed with good weather, areas not too far to our North had significant rains on Sunday which we were spared. As you know, a great deal of effort, organization and sweat goes into having a successful picnic, so thank you to all who volunteered, contributed and participated.

As I mentioned last week, this past Tuesday, August 25, I underwent cubital tunnel surgery in my right elbow, to address a recent issue of numbness in my right hand and fingers. All of that went well, I was assured, so now the major issue will be the inconvenience in having my dominant arm in a sling for 14 days, which will preclude my having Mass until after I am released. That is scheduled to be on Wednesday, September 9. Please keep my patient recovery in your prayers.

I am grateful for your dedication to the larger mission of the Church in areas where daily life and living the faith are very much a struggle. May God reward your kindness.

Sacrament of Baptism - Baptisms are celebrated during Mass on Saturdays & Sundays (not during Lent). 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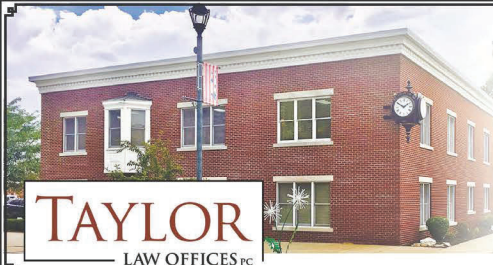
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
