### Have you been married 50+ years? Time to celebrate!

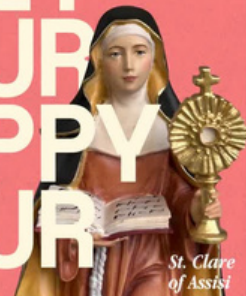

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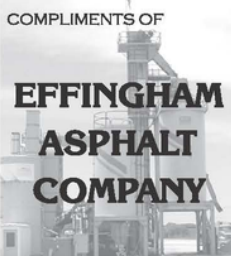
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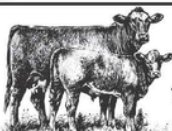


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
